Ben shares his experiences as a black man through the voice of Daniel. The story opens on the recent disappearance of Daniel's daughter Jean. Throughout his journey, Daniel fights to overcome the dangerous voice of Goliath, the monster who lives in his head.

In addition to the book, Ben's story is also the inspiration for an episodic series in development and currently seeking a production partner.

***Like the breathless pursuit of an out-of-control car chase careening on the edge of devastation or salvation, the reader accompanies Daniel through every peak and pitfall leading to the night he is forced to make a fateful choice. Young men are drawn to Ben's exciting past - older men to his calm wisdom; and, women to his sensitive compassion.***
